

After the founding of New China in 1949, hot water was already very popular. The government also promoted drinking hot water to reduce diseases because boiled water can destroy bacteria.

Nowadays, although younger generations like cold drinks, such as cola and milk tea, many older generations strongly believe that hot water can cure almost any illness, and cold water will make you sick. On the other hand, Chinese people are still faithful to hot water. When a Chinese person is sick, it is never wrong to remind him to "drink more hot water".
