## Getting Started: Chinese Window Flowers

1. There are nine sample projects included.
2. It is suggested to get the following items ready.

3. Read the directions for each pattern.
4. Look at the finished sample works included.
5. Photocopy the Black Line Masters for students. Make an extra set for the teacher to use.
6. You might want to do step by step with your students for the first project. They can be on their own to do the rest.



## Sample 2

Window flower: To celebrate Chinese New Year, Chinese cut red papers into various artistic patterns and paste them on the window. These designs could be flowers, animals, or Chinese characters. For simplicity, we can use white printer paper to cut, and mount the pattern on a red square paper.

## Steps:

1. Draw a pattern on the back of the paper. Note: Use a square paper.
2. Fold the paper in half.
3. Draw a pattern on the back of the paper.
4. Cut along the lines.
5. Turn the paper over. Turn the side with the drawing up.
6. Turn the shaded area out.
7. Open it.
8. Paste it on a red paper.
