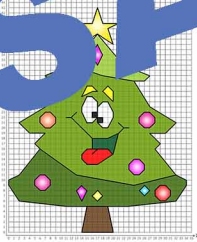

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Coordinating - First Quadrant

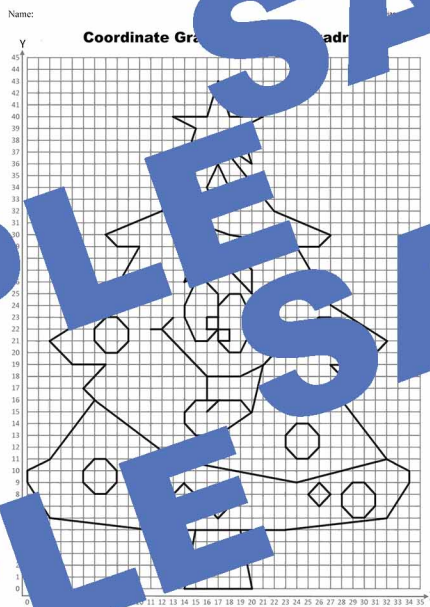
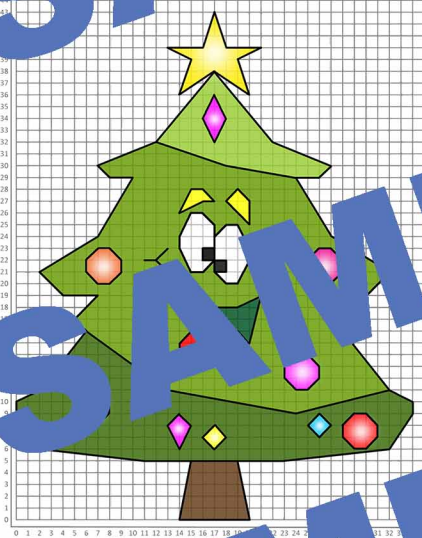
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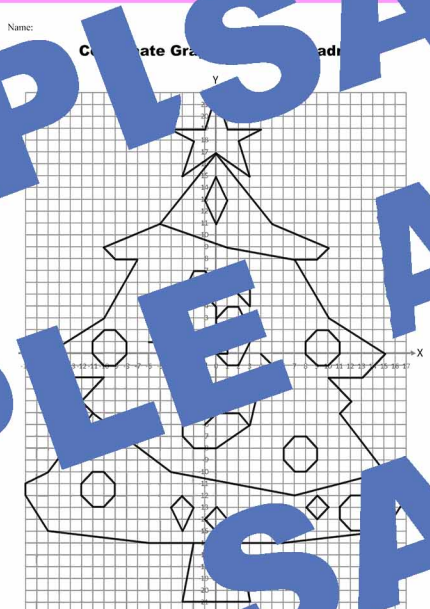
Coordinate Graphing for Quadrants
